### **WML releases wmlcups, a C++ API for CUPS, the Central Unix Printing System.**

To coincide with the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Linux Foundation Collaboration Summit and the 5<sup>th</sup> OpenPrinting Summit at the Hotel Kabuki, San Francisco, CA, WML is pleased to announce the release of its C++ API for the CUPS printing system.

wmlcups is a C++ wrapper-API which makes it much easier for developers to use the CUPS C API in their C++ programs. It is licenced under the GNU Lesser General Public License.

WML makes use of wmlcups in its own WML Print Platform, a document and print application platform built on Linux and CUPS.

WML Print Platform offerings include DataGateway, which integrates secure, SMS/email/webportal-based electronic document delivery as a parallel delivery route alongside your existing hard-copy print. DataGateway also provides a realtime document analysis module and PDF-based transactional print.
